## **How to Order:**

Call Monday through Friday 8am to 4:30 pm PST. Order before 12 noon for same-day processing of UPS shipments\*. We encourage orders to be emailed or faxed.

## **Payment Methods:**

All accounts must be PRE-PAID with company check, cashiers check, money order or credit card (we accept Visa, Master Card, Discover & American Express). No exceptions unless other arrangements are made at the time of the order with Manager approval only.

Credit applications will not be considered until ten (10) consecutive orders have been placed. Terms of an open account are Net 15 to Net 30 days and will be decided by management. Accounts that fail to adhere to payment terms will be automatically placed back to PRE-PAID basis. No orders will be processed to accounts with past due balances. There will be a \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks.

## **Prices:**

PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS AND PRICING MAY CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE. Prices do not include any applicable taxes or shipping and handling charges. Requests for alterations to ready-made signs (deleting, adding verbiage, etc.) will incur an additional fee and may delay your order.

## **Shipping:**

All shipments are sent UPS only and require a \$10.00 minimum in signs. No exceptions. For same day shipments, orders must be placed by 12 noon PST and may be affected by availability of stock. If you might need to add signs to your order, please ask that your order stay open until 12 noon PST. We will not open packages for add-ons. Shipping and handling rates are based on order weight and UPS zones. We are not responsible for UPS errors. You must report all damage claims to UPS.

PLEASE NOTE: UPS will not accept cash for COD orders. Payment can be made with company or certified check or money order.

If you request an order to be shipped directly to *your* customer, there will be a *minimum* service charge of \$10.00 plus shipping and handling.

All signs are inspected before they leave the warehouse. You must inform us about any defects or shortages within 24 hours of receipt of your order or it will be considered complete.

## **Custom Orders:**

## OPERATING RULES FOR INDUSTRIAL TRUCKS



### General Industry Safety Order 3654 Operating Rules (Part (a))

- (a) Every employer using industrial trucks or industrial tractors shall post and enforce a set of operating rules including the appropriate rules listed in Section 3655.

### General Industry Safety Order 3650 Industrial Trucks, General (Part(s))

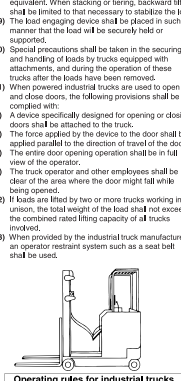
- (1) Industrial trucks and tow tractors shall be operated in a safe manner in accordance with the following operating rules:
  - (1) Only drivers authorized by the employer and trained in the safe operation of industrial trucks or industrial tractors pursuant to Section 3658 shall be permitted to operate such vehicles.
  - (2) Stunt driving and horseplay are prohibited.
  - (3) No riders shall be permitted on vehicles unless provided with adequate riding facilities.
  - (4) Employees shall not ride on the foms of lift trucks.
  - (5) Employees shall not place any part of their bodies outside the running lines of an industrial truck or between mast supports or other parts of the truck where shear or crushing hazards exist.
  - (6) Employees shall not be allowed to stand, pass, or work under the elevated portion of any industrial truck, loaded or empty, unless it is effectively blocked to prevent it from falling.
  - (7) Drivers shall check the vehicle at the beginning of each shift, and if it is found to be unsafe, the matter shall be reported immediately to a foreman or mechanic, and the vehicle shall not be put in service again until it has been made safe. Attention shall be given to the proper functioning of tires, horn, lights, battery controller, brakes, steering mechanism, cooling system, and the lift system for forklifts (forks, chains, cable, and limit switches).
  - (8) No truck shall be operated with a leak in the fuel system.
  - (9) Vehicles shall not exceed the authorized or safe speed, always maintaining a safe distance from other vehicles, keeping the truck under positive control at all times and all established traffic regulations shall be observed. For trucks traveling in the same direction, a safe distance may be considered to be approximately 3 truck lengths or

### General Industry Safety Order 3650 Industrial Trucks, General (Part(s)) (cont.)

- (10) Trucks traveling in the same direction shall not be passed at intersections, blind spots, or dangerous locations.
- (11) The driver shall slow down and sound the horn at cross aisles and other locations where vision is obstructed. If the load being carried obstructs forward view, the driver shall be required to travel with the load trailing.
- (12) Operators shall look in the direction of travel and shall not move a vehicle until certain that persons are in the clear.
- (13) Trucks shall not be driven up to anyone standing in front of a bench or other fixed object of such size that the person could be caught between the truck and object.
- (14) Grades shall be ascended or descended slowly. (A) When ascending or descending grades in excess of 10 percent, loaded trucks shall be driven with the load up grade. (B) On all grades the load and load engaging means shall be lifted back if applicable, and raised only as far as necessary to clear the road surface.
- (15) Motorized hand and hand/trailer trucks shall be operated on all grades with the load-engaging means down grade.
- (16) The forks shall always be carried as low as possible, consistent with safe operations.
- (17) When leaving a vehicle unattended (operator is over 25 feet (7.6 meters) from or out of sight of the industrial truck, the brakes are set, the mast is brought to the vertical position, and forks are left in the down position, either (A) The power shall be shut off, and when left on an idling, the wheels shall be blocked, or (B) The power may remain on provided the wheels are blocked, front and rear.
- (17) When the operator of an industrial truck is dismounted and within 25 feet (7.6 meters) of the truck which remains in the operator's view, the load engaging means shall be fully lowered, controls placed in neutral, and the brakes set to prevent movement.

### General Industry Safety Order 3650 Industrial Trucks, General (Part(s)) Continued

- Exception:** Forks on fork-equipped industrial trucks may be in the raised position for loading and unloading if the forks are raised no more than 42 inches above the level where the operator/loaders are standing, and the power is shut off, controls placed in neutral and the brakes set. If on an incline, the wheels shall be blocked.
- (18) Vehicles shall not be run onto any elevator unless the driver is specifically authorized to do so. Before entering an elevator, the driver shall determine that the capacity of the elevator will not be exceeded. Once on an elevator, the industrial truck's power shall be shut off and the brakes set.
- (19) Motorized hand trucks shall enter elevators or other confined areas with the load and forward.
- (20) Vehicles shall not be operated on floors, sidewalk doors, or platforms that will not safely support the loaded vehicle.
- (21) Prior to driving onto trucks, trailers and railroad cars, their flooring shall be checked for breaks and other structural weaknesses.
- (22) Vehicles shall not be driven in or out of highway trucks and trailers at loading docks until such trucks or trailers are securely blocked or restrained and the brakes set.
- (23) To prevent load cars from moving during loading or unloading operations, the car brakes shall be set, wheel chocks or other recognized positive stops used, and blue flags or lights displayed in accordance with Section 2323 of these Orders and Title 49, CFR, Section 213.27 which is hereby incorporated by reference.
- (24) The width of one tire on the powered industrial truck shall be the minimum distance between the edge of the truck while it is in any elevated dock, platform, freight car or truck.
- (25) Railroad tracks shall be crossed diagonally, wherever possible. Tracks shall be crossed at least 10 feet from the centerline of railroad tracks if prohibited.
- (26) No load shall be placed in excess of its rated capacity.
- (27) A loaded vehicle shall not be moved until the load is safe and unobstructed.
- (28) Extreme care shall be taken when lifting loads. Lifting forward with the load engaging means elevated shall be prohibited except when picking up a load. Elevated loads shall not be lifted forward except when the load is being deposited onto a storage rack or equivalent. When stacking or tiering, backward lift shall be limited to that necessary to stabilize the load. The load engaging device shall be placed in such a manner that the load will be securely held or supported.
- (29) Special precautions shall be taken in the securing and handling of loads by trucks equipped with attachments, and during the operation of these trucks after the loads have been removed.
- (30) When powered industrial trucks are used to open and close doors, the following provisions shall be complied with:
  - (A) A device specifically designed for opening or closing doors shall be attached to the truck.
  - (B) The force applied by the device to the door shall be applied parallel to the direction of travel of the door.
  - (C) The entire door opening operation shall be in full view of the operator.
  - (D) The truck operator and other employees shall be clear of the area where the door might fall while being opened.
- (31) If loads are lifted by two or more trucks working in unison, the total weight of the load shall not exceed the combined lifting capacity of all trucks involved.
- (32) When provided by the industrial truck manufacturer, an operator restraint system such as a seat belt shall be used.



Operating rules for industrial trucks continued on this poster are current through Register 2009, No. 44 California Code of Regulations (effective 11-27-2009). Other rules may also apply.

## EMPLOYEE RIGHTS UNDER THE FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT

THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR WAGE AND HOUR DIVISION

### FEDERAL MINIMUM WAGE

**\$7.25** PER HOUR

BEGINNING JULY 24, 2009

**OVERTIME PAY** At least 1 1/2 times your regular rate of pay for all hours worked over 40 in a workweek.

**CHILD LABOR** An employee must be at least 16 years old to work in most non-farm jobs and at least 18 to work in non-farm jobs declared hazardous by the Secretary of Labor.

Youths 14 and 15 years old may work outside school hours in various non-manufacturing, non-hazardous jobs under the following conditions:

- No more than
  - 3 hours on a school day or 18 hours in a school week;
  - 8 hours on a non-school day or 40 hours in a non-school week.
- Also, work may not begin before 7 a.m. or end after 7 p.m., except from June 1 through Labor Day, when evening hours are extended to 9 p.m. Different rules apply in agricultural employment.

**TIP CREDIT** Employees of "tipped employees" must pay a cash wage of at least \$2.13 per hour if they claim a tax credit against their minimum wage obligation. If an employer fails to combine with the employer's cash wage of at least \$2.13 per hour, the employer may not deduct any amount from the minimum hourly wage. The employer must make up the difference. Certain other conditions must also be met.

**ENFORCEMENT** The Department of Labor may recover back wages either administratively or through court action, for the employees that have been injured in violation of the law. Violations may result in civil or criminal actions.

Employers may be assessed civil money penalties of up to \$1,100 for each willful or repeated violation of the minimum wage or overtime provisions of the law and up to \$11,000 for each employee who is the subject of a violation of the Act's child labor provisions. In addition, a civil money penalty of up to \$20,000 may be assessed for each child labor violation that causes the death or serious injury of any minor employee, and such assessments may be doubled up to \$40,000 when the violations are determined to be willful or repeated. The law also prohibits discriminating against or discharging workers who file a complaint or participate in any proceeding under the Act.

- ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**
- Certain occupations and establishments are exempt from the minimum wage and/or overtime pay provisions.
  - Special provisions apply to workers in American Samoa and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
  - Some states have stronger employee protection provisions; employers must comply with both.
  - The law requires employers to display this poster where employees can readily see it.
  - Employees under 20 years of age may not be paid \$5.15 per hour during their first 90 consecutive calendar days of employment with an employer.
  - Certain Medicare students, student farmers, agricultural workers, and workers with disabilities may be paid less than the minimum wage under special certificates issued by the Department of Labor.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) of the U.S. Department of Labor has the primary responsibility for enforcing the Act. OSHA may also conduct inspections to help ensure compliance with the Act.</p> <p><b>Inspection</b></p> <p>The Act requires that a representative of the employee and a representative of the employer be present during any inspection conducted by OSHA. There are also provisions for unannounced inspections by OSHA. OSHA may also conduct inspections to help ensure compliance with the Act.</p> <p><b>Complaint</b></p> <p>Employees or their representatives have the right to file a complaint with OSHA.
